## WE FOCUS ON FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS...

We assess basic skills including reading and simple arithmetic If children cannot read, they cannot move

ahead - either in school or in life.



We use simple assessments to understand and track children's progress Understanding children's learning progress

is impossible without regular assessment to tailor teaching to the appropriate level.

#### ... PAYING ATTENTION TO EACH INDIVIDUAL CHILD....

We assess children orally, one-on-one Pen and paper assessments assume that a child can already read. We do not make that assumption.



We build on the current learning level of each individual child to help them progress We do not assume that children of the same age or grade are at the same level and learn at the same pace.

#### ... ENSURING THAT NO CHILD IS LEFT BEHIND

We assess children in their homes The best place to find a representative sample of all children, whether in school or not, is in their home.



We ensure that all children are supported to acquire basic skills

Children come from many different contexts and backgrounds. We believe that every child can learn.

- A. We generate responses from the global south that are appropriate for our shared contexts and issues, communicating and sharing our results regularly and learning from each other.
- B. We monitor and evaluate our assessments and actions in order to learn from our mistakes and take decisions based on evidence.
- C. We freely share our tools and methods with partners, volunteers, and other organizations.
