THE VENUE

The PAL Evidence For Action Forum will take place in Nairobi Kenya, on 25th – 26th November 2025.. The event will be held at The Pullman Hotel, Nairobi Upper hill, which is located 16km from the airport and is in the heart of the business district of Upper Hill. The Nairobi National Park is about 20 minutes' drive from the hotel. The park is home to herds of zebras, lions, leopards, African buffalo, wildebeests, giraffes, and more right at your doorstep.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

PASSPORT: All visitors entering Kenya must have a valid passport. The passport must have at least two blank pages and be valid for at least six months beyond the date of arrival in the country. **VISA:** All visitors who require visas are required to obtain an e-visa before departing for Kenya. If you require a multiple-entry visa, please apply well in advance of travel. The cost for a single-entry visa into Kenya is **USD 51. E-visa portal:** https://evisa.go.ke/. Remember to carry your vaccination cards, including yellow fever.

WEATHER

The temperature in Nairobi is currently averaging 18° - 25°C during the day. The mornings and evenings are chilly. You are therefore advised to carry some warm clothes.

LANGUAGE AND INTERPRETATION SERVICES

Simultaneous interpretation services will be made available in English, Spanish, French and Portuguese. Interpretation headphones and microphones will be availed to all participants. Meeting documents will also be available in English, Spanish, French and Portuguese.

SHOPPING IN NAIROBI

Shopping is generally a pleasure in Nairobi. The malls have a variety of stores, food courts and restaurants. The following are some popular shopping malls and markets:

- Village Market located approximately 20 minutes' drive from Nairobi city centre.
- Sarit Centre located in the heart of Westlands.
- Yaya Centre located in Kilimani area.
- The Junction Mall Located in Kilimani area.
- Two Rivers Mall Located along Limuru Road.
- The Waterfront Located in Karen.
- The Hub Located in Karen.
- Maasai Markets open air markets where local artefacts, jewellery, fabric, souvenirs, and many more local items can be found.

SAFETY

It is advisable to avoid walking alone in isolated places and back streets both during the day and night. At the hotel, familiarize yourself with the fire exits, especially those on your floor and know where they come out.
